President's Report:

These are stimulus projects from the California government which provides the money to plant trees, concrete work and labor. Idea is to stimulate the local economy by creating jobs. The government wants projects that are ready to go and she was looking for suggestions of trails that need work or installation.

Suggestions given:

- Reforest of Stetson Park
- Entrance gate at Wentworth and Foothill, greeting to Shadow Hills/Sunland
- Trail along Wentworth
- Trail at Wheatland

The Reforest of Stetson Park requires a commitment from the community to maintain the trees, such as scheduled watering. Corral 20 defers to Corral 12 for decision on maintenance, and will support Corral 12 with their decision.
