

Minutes for ETI Corral 20 General Membership Meeting September 29, 2010

Meeting called to order 7:00 PM

Members present: Randy Hammock, Terry Kaiser, Debra Mader, Lynda Jones, Lynda Fenneman, Joe Dohmen, Antoinette Dohman.

Two gifts/awards received, from Ahead With Horses and the Pacific Crest Trail Association, and were handed to president Randy Hammock. These were for our support over the past year.

Antoinette presented the treasurers report.

There was discussion about missing minutes in order to authorize payments. We need minutes for payment of \$500 for the Corral 20 donation to the computer fund.

There was discussion about the \$250 to hang the Corral 20 Banner at Convention, Terry Kaiser said he would get an invoice from the \$250.

Lynda Fenneman Talked about getting Corral members to work on the local trails. Much discussion took place and it was decided that if the Corral members would not work on trail themselves (We know there are a few and their dedication is greatly appreciated), that the Corral would provide funds to help pay day laborers to work on the trails under Corral or designated representative's supervision. We will, support our trails however we can.

Linda Jones wanted to make a motion to allocate funds for doing trail work, when it was pointed out that we already have \$800 preallocated to pay for trail work in the local area. Linda Jones will head up a work party on Nov 6<sup>th</sup>. Antoinette will be sending another \$200 from the remaining \$800 of the local trails maintenance funds to William Nichols for continued support. Lynda Fenemman will be contact William to discuss his needs and make plans for the Nov 6<sup>th</sup> work party.

Linda Jones talked about the Foothill Mounted Patrol and how much of a positive affect the FMP is having on the Hansen Dam Rec Area. They are looking for "startup" funds to purchase supplies, pay for training and other incidentals. Currently, much of the funding is coming from the leader Renee Herrera. They have applied for 501(c)3 status but not yet received it. They currently have approximately 60 members who in threes for two 3 hour shifts on Sundays and Saturdays.

Lynda Jones Moved, Seconded by Joe Dohmen, that Corral 20 donate \$1000 (One Thousand Dollars) to the Foothill Mounted Patrol as startup funds to be used as needed.

Motion carried by unanimous vote

Anoinette makes a motion to donate \$500 each to BCHCA and the PCTA.

Lynda Feneman seconds.

Discussion: While we want to concentrate on local trail issues, these two organizations perform a great service maintaining trails that we do use when we travel outside of our local area.

The motion carries by unanimous vote.

The President reminded everyone to think of nominations for the upcoming elections.
